Instructions for taking the Department of Mathematics Placement Exam remotely

Purpose: The Department of Mathematics Placement Exam is for students who would like permission to register in one of the restricted mathematics (Math 140, 203, 215, 241, 251A) or physics (Phys 151) courses at the University of Hawaii at Manoa. Other campuses within the University of Hawaii system have their own exam.

Before requesting a remote exam, please read:

- <u>math.hawaii.edu/home/pdf/Exceptions.pdf</u> (who does not need the exam).

For whom: Students who are freshly admitted to the University of Hawaii at Manoa with a home address not on the island of Oahu may take the Department of Mathematics Placement Exam from a remote site.

What is needed: To take the exam, students need their University of Hawaii Student ID number and a University of Hawaii login.

Where: Eligible students may take the exam at any one of the *National College Testing Association* sites. See <u>www.ncta-testing.org</u> for a list of sites.

Procedure: Contact the approved testing center of your choice and arrange a time and date for the one-hour exam. Have the testing center contact the Department of Mathematics at the University of Hawaii at Manoa (<u>office@math.hawaii.edu</u>) at least 10 days before the intended exam date. They must send us your name and ID number and exam time and date. We then send them instructions for administering the exam.

Disability Access: If you have a documented disability and are requesting accommodation in taking the mathematics placement exam, please contact UH Manoa's office for students with disabilities (the KOKUA program) at <u>kokua@hawaii.edu</u> or (808)-956-7511 to verify your disability status.

Things to consider:

- You may take the exam when you come to Oahu. In-person exam dates in the department computer lab are frequent and available until the end of the first week of classes. The department makes every effort, generally successful, to find a seat for every eligible student.
- Students who take the exam at a remote site are responsible for all fees charged by the remote site. There is no charge for in-person exams taken in the department.
- The placement exam may be taken only once, on campus or at an NCTA testing site, within each of the time periods March 16th to July 15th, July 16th to November 15th, and November 16th to March 15th.
- Advising is available after in-person exams.
