

Tiger Travels



Materials:

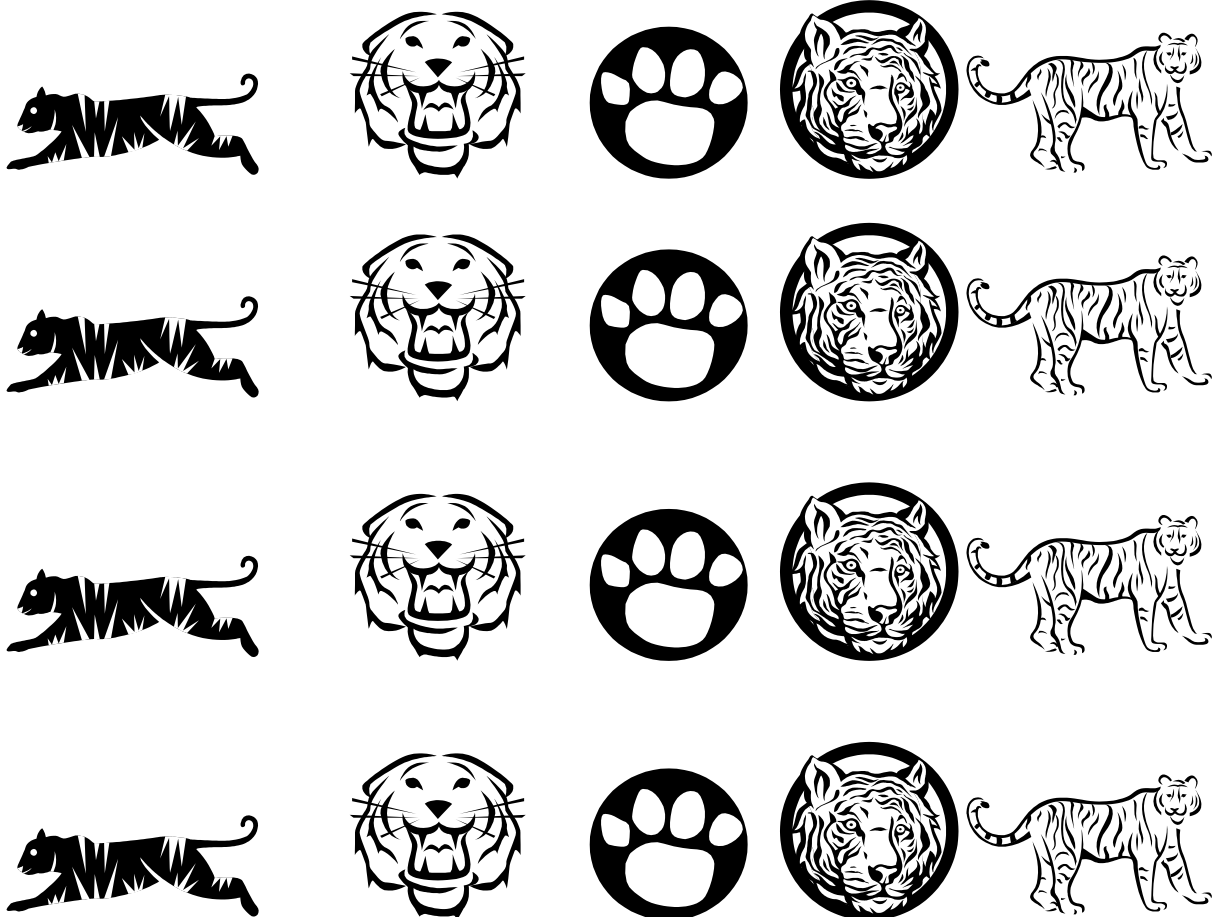
Once die or a spinner

Game pieces or tokens (a sheet of game pieces are provided and can be cut out)

Instructions:

1. Have each student choose a playing piece and determine who goes first
2. students will roll dice or spin the spinner and move their game pieces following all directions on the board
3. Student who gets to the end first will be named the Species recovery team leader.
4. All students should complete the game and save their tigers

Playing pieces



Guide your tiger safely to the wildlife preserve.



Camouflage stripes help tigers avoid hunters. Forward 2 spaces

Bulldozer clears forest: Go back to start!

Tiger cub taken as a pet. Go back one space.



Tiger skin products banned: Free Turn

Tiger Prey multiplies. Move Forward one space.

Tiger skin seized from poacher. Go back 3 spaces.

Three Cubs Born. Go Forward 4 spaces.



Snake bites kill one cub. Lose a turn.

Natives make money from ecotourism. Forward 2 spaces.

Forest Fire: Go Back Four Spaces.

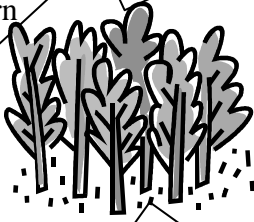


Caught prey. Move forward one space.

Hunter kills one tiger. Go back six spaces.

CITES bans trade in endangered species: free turn

Traditional Medicine using tiger bone becomes popular. Go back 3 spaces.



Wildlife preserve built. Move 3 spaces forward.

Cubs able to hunt alone at one year. One space forward.
