ENTRY AND DEADLINE

1. To partially defray the cost of printing programs, problems, certificates, trophies, lunch, facilities, and equipment, each person (coach, chaperone, student participant, student observer) that attends the Math Bowl shall be assessed an entry fee of **\$21.00**.

2. **Outer island teams are especially invited to compete!** This is a unique chance for all teams from the state to compete with each other! All teams are responsible for their own air transportation costs, vehicle renting expenses, as well as lodging and food charges in addition to the entry fee.

3. All entry fee checks should be made payable to the BYU-Hawaii Mathematics Department.

Deadline for Participation in the Math Bowl: April 4, 2018 – Wednesday. Application Forms for the Math Bowl and the **\$21.00** per person entry fee must be received by Scott Hyde at the address on the right by the deadline.
